It will not collect or publish any personal information about you through its homepage or homepages related to its activity without clear permission. Any personal information which you volunteer to Cognitio will be treated with the highest security and confidentiality, strictly in accordance to the latest data protection acts.

Personal information – collection and use

Collection and use of technical information

The web page of Cognitio uses temporary "session" cookies which enable a visitor's web browser to remember which pages on this website have already been visited. No other information is stored in the cookie. Visitors can use this website with no loss of functionality if cookies are disabled for the web browser. Technical details in connection with visits to this website are logged by our internet service provider for our statistical purposes. No information is collected that could be used by us to personally identify website visitors. The technical details logged are confined to the following items:

- the IP address of the visitor's web server
- the top-level domain name used (for example .ie, .com, .org, .net)
- the previous website address from which the visitor reached us, including any search terms used
- Google analytics which shows the traffic of visitors around this web site (for example pages accessed and documents downloaded)
- The type of web browser and operating system used by the website visitor.

Cognitio will make no attempt to identify individual visitors, or to associate the technical details listed above with any individual. It is the policy of the Cognitio never to disclose such technical information in respect of individual website visitors to any third party (apart from our internet service provider, which records such data on our behalf and which is bound by confidentiality provisions in this regard), unless obliged to disclose such information by law. The technical information will be used only by the Cognitio and only for statistical and other administrative purposes
